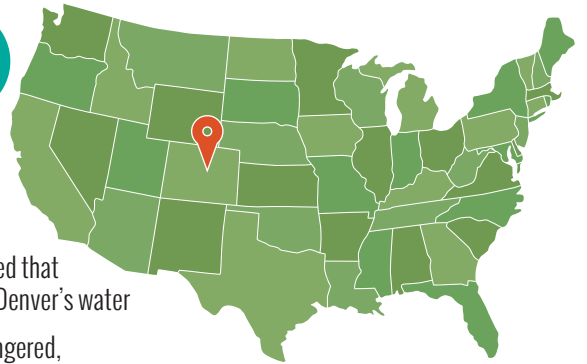

REASON FOR PLANTING
